

Bagley Pass to Red Clover Valley to Crocker Guard Station

Ride Type:	One way ride, spotting a car at Crocker CG and Guard Station. Easy Dirt Bike Ride.
Distance:	Total of 12.5 miles
Elevation:	Start: 6190'; Highest Point: 6190'; Lowest Point: 5438 (Difference of 752')
Scenery:	Lovely forests, then lush valley
Season:	May to October (possible mud or snow other months)

Directions to Trailhead

From the Lake Davis Dam, go east .5 miles to the Grizzly/Lake Davis Road. Take left and go 4.4 miles, till pavement ends. Continue to Bagley Pass turnoff at 5.5 miles (Forest Service {FS} Road 24N08). Go 1 mile to Bagley Pass.

General Description

To make this only 12.4 easy miles, park one vehicle at Bagley Pass, having parked another vehicle at the Crocker Guard Station on the Beckwourth-Genesee Road, north of Beckwourth, from SR 70.
